This sculpture is located on a prominent roundabout at the intersection of two of Ireland's main roadways. The castle is a 6-meter high, 3D grid structure made from Grade 316L Stainless Steel box section. It is finished to a Shot Peened finish as the architect required a non-reflective finish. The castle was designed to proportionally suggest the robust form of a square Norman tower and was inspired by Carlow Castle which is located nearby.
